Their decision is final.

Scotia Speedworld follows INEX rules as provided by INEX, however the following are additions to those rules issued by INEX.

1. **GENERAL**

- 1.1. Drivers must have a current year INEX membership to compete at Scotia Speedworld Weekly Racing Series events. A two-race grace period will be given to allow new drivers time to try a car before purchasing it.
- 1.2. Maximum age for competition is 16 years old. Drivers who turn 17 years old during the season will not be allowed to compete once they turn 17 years old.

2. **SAFETY**

1.1. FIRE EXTINGUISHER

- 1.1.1. A securely fastened, quick release 2.5 lb. fire extinguisher is to be mounted on the floor immediately in front of the driver's seat.
- 1.1.2. Recharge slip dated no earlier than January first of the current year.
- 1.1.3. Brackett securing fire extinguisher to car must be metal. No plastic brackets.
- 1.1.4. Cars with working fire suppression system, do not require a fire extinguisher.

1.2. KILL SWITCH

- 1.2.1. Kill Switch is to be mounted on left side rear deck of interior tin.
- 1.2.2. Kill switch must shut off engine and fuel pump.
- 1.3. Full containment seats are recommended.
- 1.4. Safety Harnesses will be replaced as specified by manufactures.
- 1.5. Full face helmet must be Snell SA or SAH 2015 or newer.
- 1.6. Helmet must be free of cracks and must accompany car at time if inspection.
- 1.7. Drivers must wear a S.F.I. fire rated Driving Suite. Note, a two layer or a single layer suite combined with S.F.I. fire rated underwear will be required in 2022.

3 FUEL

- 3.1 Pump gas only, Maxine grade highest.
- 3.2 No additives permitted.
- 3.3 Competitors fuel will be compared to track samples taken from the major fuel companies.

4 FRONT SUSPENSION

4.1 The new proposed suspension system for the Bandolero Cars does not have a release date, but development work continues by INEX. **Last we heard they were still working on it, but no date range when a decision will be announced.**

5 TIRES

- 5.1 The Hoosier Bandolero tire, as supplied by INEX, is the official tire at Scotia Speedworld for for 2021. The older INEX tire will not be permitted.
- 5.2 A 62 durometer reading is in effect.
